The undersigned is informed and believes that:

It is further alleged that in the offenses committed above, the said defendants, CHARLES STEVEN COX, took, damaged, and destroyed property of a value exceeding \$2,500,000.00, within the meaning of Penal Code Section 12022.6 (a)(4).

It is further alleged that in the offenses committed above, the said defendants, CHARLES STEVEN COX, took, damaged, and destroyed property of a value exceeding \$1,000,000.00, within the meaning of Penal Code Section 12022.6(a)(3).

It is further alleged that in the offenses committed above, the said defendants, CHARLES STEVEN COX and TAD THERON HONEYCUTT, took, damaged, and destroyed property of a value exceeding \$150,000.00, within the meaning of Penal Code Section 12022.6(a)(2).

It is further alleged that in the offenses committed above, the said defendants, CHARLES STEVEN COX and TAD THERON HONEYCUTT, took, damaged, and destroyed property of a value exceeding \$50,000.00, within the meaning of Penal Code Section 12022.6(a)(1).




